

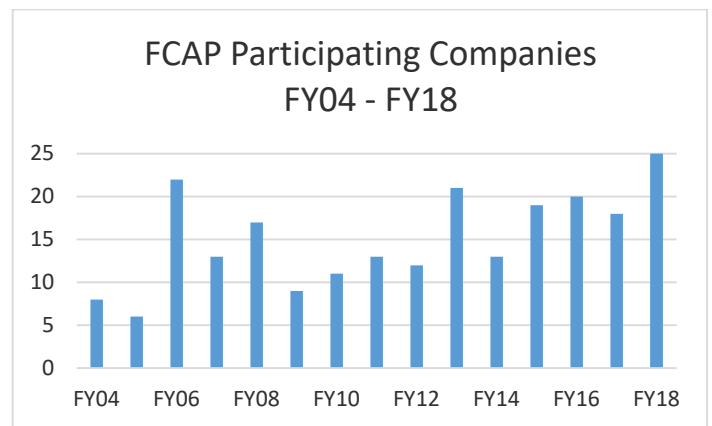
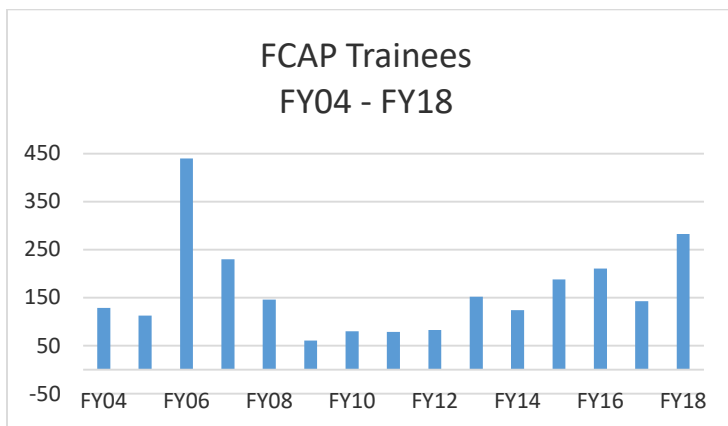
Film Crew Advancement Program (FCAP)

Through the Job Training Incentives Program (JTIP) for film and multimedia, the NMFO supports economic development in New Mexico by providing training opportunities to below-the-line crew.

*Since FY04 – FY18: 227 companies have participated with 2,462 New Mexico trainees.
The average wage of trainees for FY18 is \$22.29.*

Pre-Employment Training Program (PETP)

2006 - YTD

The Pre-Employment Training Program (PETP) was developed by NMFO to assist New Mexico's economy by providing reimbursement funds to contractors facilitating short-term intensive workshops and lectures that primarily relate to below-the-line film and television job positions. The program objective is to increase the hirability of New Mexicans for continual employment in the film and television industry.

Since FY06, twenty-nine (29) interactive workshops and lectures have taken place with six hundred and thirty-two (632) New Mexico participants. Total reimbursement is \$151,622.42.
